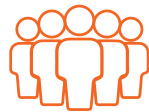

Need For Green Homes

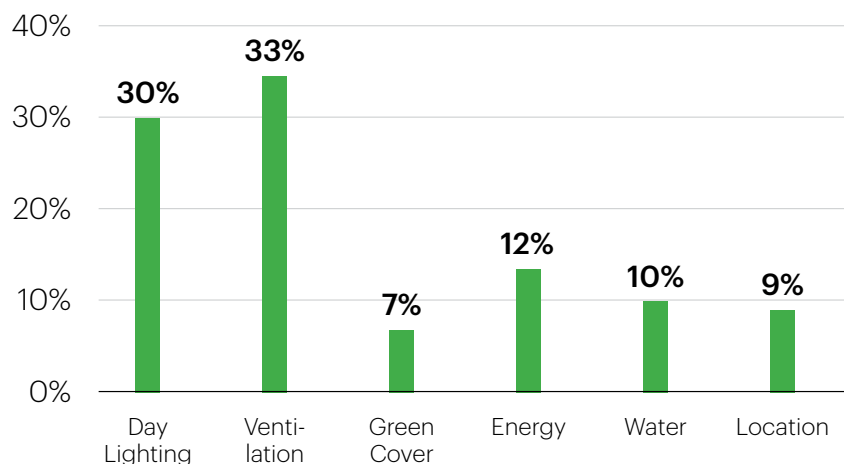
India has witnessed significant growth in the building sector during the past decade. Yet, many reports indicate that the growth during the next 10 years would be many-fold higher. It is the housing sector that needs to be watched where it is anticipated that the growth would be higher than the commercial sectors. Even during the recent years of a rather lower growth in the construction sector.

The buildings sector accounts for about 37% of energy and process-related CO2 emissions worldwide and 34% of global energy demand [Source: UNEP]. This sector has a major role to play in enhancing resource efficiency in the coming years.

Eco-friendly designs are not alien to the Indian ethos. Historically, there has been excellent rendition of eco-sensitivity in the design of many monuments. The challenge today is how such an approach can be made the mainstream of design philosophy.

Green practices adopted in residential buildings can substantially reduce or eliminate negative environmental impacts. As an added benefit, green homes reduce operating costs, enhance marketability in the case of residential apartments, and reduce health problems resulting from indoor air quality problems.

In a survey conducted by the **CII – Indian Green Building Council (IGBC)** to comprehend stakeholders' perceptions on what they perceive as a 'green home'. The respondents were asked to choose top three green features, while buying a house, which they would not compromise.



The target groups were from across the 5 climatic zones and were from middle-class and upper middle-class segments.

Interestingly, the IGBC survey results showed that more than 60 of the respondents have chosen daylighting and ventilation as top priorities on which they would not compromise. Energy efficiency and water savings, which were opted for by about 22% of respondents were found to be next priorities.



IGBC's Exclusive Rating System for Green Homes

IGBC rated green projects offer tremendous savings in terms of energy (up to 20- 30%, as compared to baseline) and water consumption (up to 50% over baselines) along with the enhancement of occupant's health & wellbeing.

The housing sector in the country needs to make judicious shifts towards sustainable living so as to live a better earth for posterity. As on date, India has almost 15 lakh dwelling units going green under IGBC Green Homes Rating System.

Against this background, the Indian Green Building Council (IGBC) has launched 'IGBC Green Homes Rating System' to address National priorities. By applying IGBC Green Homes criteria, homes which are sustainable over the life cycle of the building can be constructed. This rating programme is a tool which enables the designer to apply green concepts and criteria, so as to reduce environmental impact, that are measurable. The programme covers methodologies to cover diverse climatic zones and changing lifestyles.

IGBC Green Homes is the first rating programme developed in India, exclusively for the residential sector. It is based on accepted energy and environmental principles and strikes a balance between known established practices and emerging concepts. The system is designed to be comprehensive in scope, yet simple in operation.

IGBC rating systems are based on the five elements of nature (Panchabhutas) and are a perfect blend of ancient architectural practices and modern technological innovations. IGBC rating programmes have become National by Choice and Global in Performance.

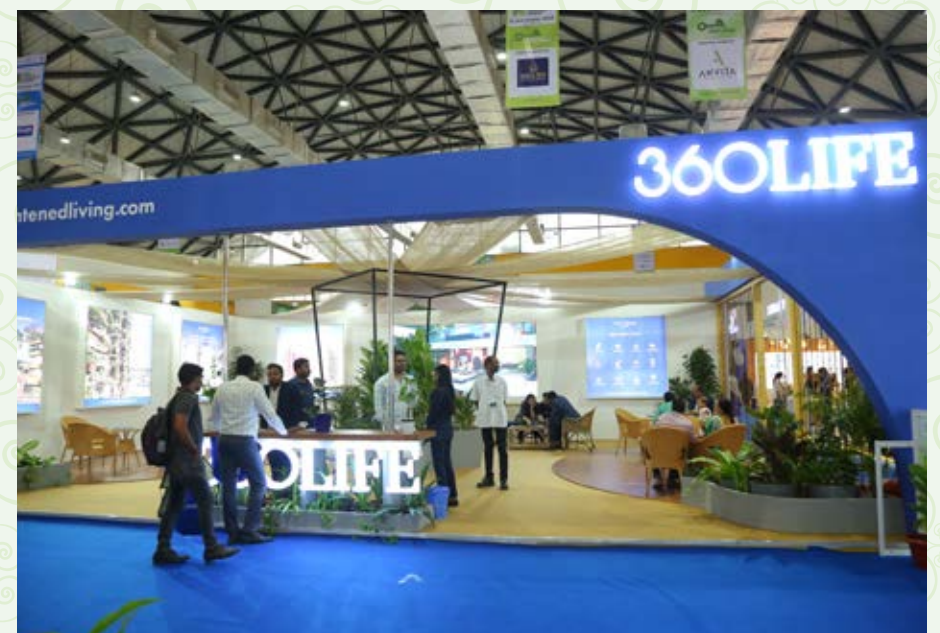

IGBC marching towards achieving 50 bn sft green building footprint in India by 2047

The newly-appointed National Vice Chairman of Confederation of Indian Industry's (CII) Indian Green Building Council (IGBC), C Shukar Reddy, beaming optimism about the future of the green building movement in India told Biz Buzz that with the concerted efforts of all stakeholders, along with focus on inclusivity and accessibility, the transition towards a more sustainable built environment can be accelerated. Currently, India holds second position globally for highest number of registered green building footprint. IGBC has certified 11,675 billion sq ft across 13,380 projects. With an ambition to secure the first position globally, the Council has set its sight on certifying 50 billion sq ft of green building footprint by 2047.

The Indian government has been actively promoting green building initiatives through policies, incentives, and regulations in 11 States. With continued government support, we can expect to see greater adoption across IGBC member States, advances in technology such as smart building systems, renewable energy integration, and building automation will play a crucial role in making green buildings more efficient and sustainable. Early engagement, cross-industry collaboration, and developers, architects, engineers, manufacturers and policymakers will drive innovation in sustainable construction practices.

With their focus on the future of green building movement for more than three decades, CII and IGBC are committed to hold the movement on across India. 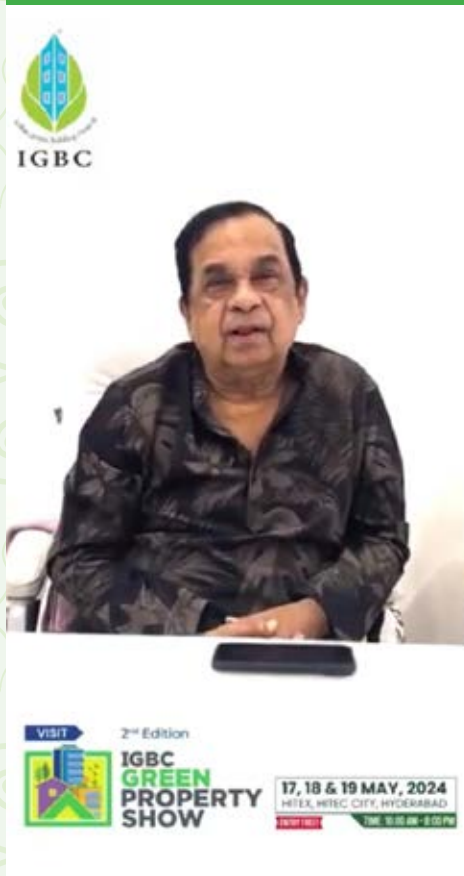

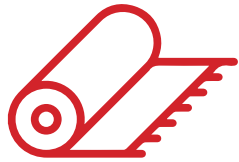
